Procedures in the classroom

When your child arrives to his or her classroom they will:

- go directly to the classroom sink and wash their hands
- bring all their individual items to their desks (which are physically distant)
- have an individual supply box where all their materials (pencils, crayons, workbooks, crafts, etc.) will be housed.
 - wear their masks throughout the day with hourly mask breaks
 - have multiple opportunities for outside time. (recess, specials, mask breaks)
 - eat breakfast (if needed) and lunch in our classroom.
 - have a snack break in the afternoon.
- wash their hands frequently throughout the day. (prior to meals, returning from specials, and restroom use)

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The first two months of school will be based around the following guiding principles:

- Getting to know each individual child
- The social-emotional well-being of each individual
 - Reacclimating to a classroom community
- Classroom routines, expectations and procedures
- Working to find where your child is academically and meet their independent needs

Academic Guiding Principles:

- Becoming an independent reader
- Planning and writing a five star piece of work
- Understanding math concepts such as place value, numbers to 120, addition, and subtraction
- Exploring science topics- plant and animal superpowers, spinning sky and lights and sound
 - Social Emotional Learning (Community Building and Citizenship)



- 8:05-8:30 Arrival and Morning Routines
- 8:30-9:00 Morning Meeting with social emotional focus and check-ins
- 9:00-11:20 Academics
- *Recess will be at least a half hour each day, but time of day may vary
- 11:20-11:50 Lunch and handwashing
- 12:00-1:00 Clean-Up, Transitions, Special
- 1:00-2:45 Academics
- *Snack will be scheduled during the academic block each afternoon
- 2:45-3:10 End of Day meeting, social emotional check-in and dismissal routine



Your child will be involved on:

- Seesaw: The main platform to capture student learning, communicate, and assemble student work
 - Class Dojo: Main platform for family communication
 - RAZ Kids
 - BrainPop
 - Mystery Science
- Paper packets will be sent home regularly, covering all academic areas in order to reinforce classroom
 learning
 - Wednesdays: Be on the lookout around mid-September for a dedicated Zoom Meeting time for all students (this will be a time for students from all cohorts to get to know one another)
