RULES FOR STUDENTS RIDING BICYCLES TO/FROM SCHOOL 2020-21

The most important aspect of riding a bicycle to and from school is safety. With the Baldwin Middle School on a main road, there are safeguards in place to reduce risk and increase safety.

- No student is allowed to ride to and from school without written permission from a parent/guardian.
- Helmets must be worn at all times.
- Bicycle riding is not allowed in the school yard.
- Upon entering the upper driveway, students must walk their bikes to the rack located in front of the art room.
- When leaving the school yard students must walk their bikes to the upper driveway.
- Students riding bicycles home will be dismissed following all buses leaving the school.
- The school will not be responsible for loss or damage to bicycles. It is recommended that students lock their bicycles to the rack.

Students not complying with the above rules will lose the privilege of riding their bicycle to and from school.
