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Dear Parents and Guardians,

The CPS team has been working hard to get our classrooms ready for next week. Opening schools in a hybrid model has certainly been a new learning experience for staff and families.

When schools closed in March, I remember teachers remarking how remote learning was only achievable because they all had developed relationships with their students prior to the closure. There was a general feeling that trying to engage students in remote learning without an established relationship would have been a challenge.

Our opening of schools in the hybrid model will give teachers an opportunity to engage with their students in a small group setting. Students will be able to learn new routines at school in a small group setting. While we understand some families have elected to start the year in a full remote model, know that your child is a contributing member of the classroom. His or her success is equally important and their full engagement in the learning activities will be necessary.

The first two weeks of school will be focused on establishing new routines and getting-to-know-you activities. Remote learning activities and expectations will be limited during our transition into a hybrid learning model.
