- Students will wear masks in the classroom and throughout the building. There will be designated "mask breaks" at least every hour.
- Each child will have a desk shield for their own desk.

- Students will be asked to remain at least six feet away from each other while in the classroom.
- Students will have their own individualized set of materials at school.
- Teachers will work to create "Classroom Constitutions" with students to support behavior, effort, and academic guidelines.



# Summary of Concepts Covered in Third Grade

Math: Place value concepts in addition and subtraction, introduction to multiplication and division, fractions, geometry (area/perimeter and polygons), graphing

Reading: Character Study, Main Idea, Point of View, Theme, Text Features, Compare and Contrast within the same text and by different texts

Science: Animals and their Habitats, Forces and Motion, Weather, Plants

Social Studies: History and economies of the town of Canterbury and the state of Connecticut
