

Parent Technology Resource Guide

This guide has been created to assist Teachers, Parents, and Students with the various technology communication tools that we are using at Canterbury Elementary School. You will not need to access all of these tools, so you can just focus on the tools used in the students' class.

Technology Communication Tools

Teachers may use multiple tools for optimum communication. The communication tools that will be presented here are Class Dojo, Seesaw, and Google Classroom.

Class Dojo

Class Dojo will be the main communication tool for grades Pre-K through 4.

Google Classroom

Some teachers (mainly grades 3 and 4) will use google classroom to communicate assignments, post messages and resources.

To setup students with their class, they must be joined to their class. How to [join a google classroom](#).

Class On-line Meetings

For class meetings, teachers will mostly use either Google Meet or Zoom.

Parent Expectations & Support:

Please have your child eat before class, help them to make sure they have school materials ready, and help your child to log in to class until they are ready to do these things themselves. During the meeting, you should be close by in case technical help is needed. Remember, the camera and microphone may be on so we can all see and hear you.

Also, please help your child to complete the work assigned and to turn it in.

After the meeting, set up regular break times for eating and movement.

Student Expectations:

Be respectful by muting your microphone if not speaking, raise your hand and wait to be called to speak, and speak clearly. Be responsible and have your school materials ready, complete all your work, and focus on the teacher. Find a quiet place, be on time, and have a positive attitude!

Zoom

To begin using zoom, you may have to download the app. This may automatically happen the first time you click on a link that the teacher provides to you.

Google Meet

The teacher will provide the link for you to join their class meeting.
