Dear CES Families:

It seems amazing that we have finished our first trimester! Report cards will be sent home next Friday, November 20th. Parent/teacher conferences are the following Monday and Tuesday. We have sent home a conference letter and reached out for scheduling. Please let your teacher know if you haven't yet signed up for a conference!

When you get your child's report card, it may have lower grades than you are accustomed to seeing for your child. For example, your child may have gotten 3s in the past which indicated that the child was meeting the standard for this trimester. You may see a 2 this trimester. This is due to the fact that all students started the year in a different place than usual because of the pandemic and school closure last spring. Please do not fret about these changes! Your child's teacher will let you know if she or he has any concerns about how your child is progressing at the conference.

You will also see that a few skills have an "x" in the box on the report card. This is again because we started the year in a different place than usual. We have not changed the report card, but instead have noted if a specific skill was not covered.

It is our goal to continue to support our students as they continue to grow and learn. It looks a little different this year!

For our students who are fully remote, there will be a cover page on the front of the report card that reflects the needs of a remote learner. On our CES website, you can find a copy of the "Cover page for Remote Students' Report Card" to see what it will look like.
