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March 19, 2021 Dear Baldwin families, Happy Friday. I hope you are all able to enjoy what looks to be a beautiful, sunny weekend coming up!

First off, next week grades 7/8 will be fully remote, due to a staffing shortage. Grade 7 and 8 students will follow their regular remote/snow day learning schedule. Students will be expected to log on to every class period and will be expected to finish all classwork and homework that is assigned. Please see below for a copy of the schedule. This schedule change will have no impact on grades 5 and 6. Grades 5 and 6 will still come to school in-person and have a normal learning schedule.

Second, beginning on Monday, March 29, we will begin our state assessments at BMS. Our testing will run from March 29 to April 9. Please speak with your student about the importance of getting a good night's sleep as well as eating a nutritious breakfast.

As testing gets underway, I am asking for all remote families to consider having your students come into school to complete their testing. We have prepared a separate setting for remote students, that will not expose them to any of our in-school peers, and that will be thoroughly cleaned before and after they leave. In addition, we will have transportation available to pick up remote learners for testing and to drop them off at home once they finish. Next week we will be reaching out directly to all remote families to gauge their interest in this offer.

For in-person students, testing will occur in the morning. Students will then follow their regular schedule, with shortened periods.
