This summer we have an exciting opportunity for Canterbury students who are going into grades 6-8! We are offering enrichment programs to all students who would like to participate.

Here are the details:

- Programs will run Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays July 6th to July 29th from 9-12. Please see each course description for the specific week(s) that program is running.
- There will be limited spaces in each program.
- We will try our best to give each student their first choice. If they are interested in participating in multiple programs please indicate their other choices on the sheet and if there is room students will be able to participate in multiple programs.
- Programs will be filled on a first come, first serve basis so get your forms back ASAP!

## Enrichment Programs

### ***Week One and Three: Deep Dive into Pottery!***

***(July 6-8 and July 20-22)***

Students will be introduced to the pottery wheels, coil building, and hand-built slab pottery. In week three, students will glaze the work they made in week one, as well as learn how to use and operate the kiln. Students will have the opportunity to explore using high-fire glazes as well as paint with underglaze and learn how to sgraffito.

### ***Week Two: Murals!***

***(July 13-15)***

Come help work in the hallways of BMS to create new, unique and beautiful artwork for the students in your school to see and appreciate. Students will work in small groups to design and create original artwork they will turn into large scale paintings. Students will also be able to finish any works that are currently incomplete from the mural project started last spring if they would like.

### ***Week Four: Nature Photography and Nature Art***

***(July 27-29)***

Students will have the opportunity to work on their digital photography skills, landscape painting and drawing, as well as create artwork from things we find in nature.
