#### Did You Know!

The Canterbury Elementary School Library received a major overhaul this summer. Through the Town's Capital Improvement Program and the school budget we replaced the flooring in the library and repaired the air conditioner. This \$40,000 investment was also supported by a \$9,000 purchase of new books for the library. Mrs. Sweeney's foresight and passion has helped the CES library become a current and relevant resource for our students.

On Wednesday, October 6, the Canterbury Education Foundation donated \$5,000 for the purchase of new books for the Dr. Helen Baldwin Middle School Library.
