This position will focus on math instruction from the PreK through 8th grade levels, and the ideal candidate will have math competency throughout these grades. The ideal candidate will have knowledge of, or willingness to learn, evidence-based techniques for supporting the academic, communication and social/emotional development of children. Restorative practices with a trauma informed lens is a critical attribute of the ideal paraeducator for this position, who may split time between the elementary and middle schools. The person in this position may work 1:1 with students, in a regular education classroom, or with a small group of learners, and will be required to perform other duties as needed throughout the district.
