Thank you Bus Drivers!

It takes a special person to be a bus driver. Our Canterbury drivers are responsible for the safety of our students each day. We are fortunate to have a special group that is dedicated to our community!

Throughout Connecticut there is a shortage of bus drivers that has reached a critical tipping point. Nearly every transportation organization is experiencing a shortage of drivers with a CDL license. To be a bus driver you need additional endorsements and the certification process can take months.

In Canterbury when a driver is absent we will need to make run adjustments, often at the last minute. Our drivers have an excellent attendance record but absences will occur from time to time. Unfortunately, we anticipate that transportation issues will happen frequently this year.
